Personal Tax Return Document Checklist

*NOT an exhaustive list - just for examples!

Income

- O Forms W2 from "Traditional" Jobs
- O Forms 1099-NEC from Non-employment Compensation (Contractors, "Gig" Jobs)
- Schedules K-1 from S-Corps, Partnerships, or Trusts (or Form 1041 for Distributions from a Trust)
- O Forms 1099-B from Stocks, Bonds, Mutual Funds, or Cryptocurrency
- O Forms 1099-DIV or 1099-INT from Dividends or Interest Earned
- Forms 1099-S and Closing Documents if you Sold a Home
- Forms 1099-SA for Funds Spent from a HSA or MSA
- Forms 1099-G for Unemployment or Federal, State, or Local Government Payments
- O Forms SSA-1099 or SSA-1042S for Social Security Benefits Received
- O Forms 1099-R for Retirement Income and Distributions (Including Rollovers)
- O Forms W2-G from Gambling Winnings
- O Forms 1099-MISC for Royalties, Real Estate Income, or Miscellaneous Income
- O Forms 1099-K from Third-Party Transactions such as Shopify Payments, Paypal, Etsy, Square, etc.
- O Records of Any Other Taxpayer or Household Income

Identification

- O Social Security Number or ITIN (And Spouse's if Filing Joint)
- O Unexpired Photo ID (Drivers License, State ID, Passport Including Spouse's if Filing Jointly)
- O IP PIN (if Assigned one by the IRS Including Spouse's if Filing Jointly)
- O Copies of Previous Tax Returns (3 Years if Possible)
- O Bank Routing and Account Number for Direct Deposit/Withdraw Purposes

If you are Claiming Dependents:

- O Dependents Social Security Numbers or ITINs
- O Dependents IP PIN (if Assigned one by the IRS)
- O Form 8332 for Dependents of Which you are NOT the Custodial Parent
- O Proof of Residence for Dependents (School/Doctor Records, Leases, Court Records, Social Service Records

Deductions/Credits

- O Mortgage Interest, Points Paid (Form 1098), and Property Tax Records if you Own a Home
- O Medical Expenses (If More than 7.5% of your Adjusted Gross Income Only Deducted if you Itemize)
- O Childcare Expenses (Including Provider's EIN or SSN, Address, and Total Paid)
- O Educational Expenses (Form 1098-T, Tuition, Fees, and Expenses Paid to Eligible Postsecondary Institutions)
- O HUD-1 Settlement Statement and Closing Documents if you Purchased or Refinanced a Home
- O Receipts For Eco-Friendly Energy-Efficient Home Upgrades or Electric Vehicle Purchases
- O Vehicle Sales Tax Paid if you Purchased or Leased a Vehicle
- O Receipts of Charity Donations (Only Deducted if you Itemize)
- O Student Loan Interest (Form 1098-E)
- O Teacher Expenses (if you are an Eligible Educator, up to \$300 per Taxpayer)
- O HSA/MSA Contributions (Form 5498-SA)
- O Moving Expenses (for Active Duty Military Members Only)
- O Alimony (if Divorce or Separation Agreement was Made BEFORE Jan 1, 2019)
- O Form 1095-A if you had Health Insurance Through the Marketplace
